CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All nominations must be in writing and reach Canungra AH&I Society Inc, PO Box 47, CANUNGRA QLD 4275 no later than the 25th October 2011. No telephone or late nominations will be accepted.
2. Each entry must be accompanied by the full nomination fee. All cheques/money orders to be made payable to Canungra & District AH&I Society Inc.
3. Competitors must wear a hat or safety helmet, not a cap, boots, collared full-buttoned shirt and long trousers in competitions at all times. Competitors must be neat and presentable.
4. Competitors must be suitably attired and mounted for the presentations.
5. All teams will be run in the order of the draw.
6. All competitors, in all events, compete at their own risk.
7. The decision of the Committee on all matters will be final.
8. The Committee reserves the right to alter or cancel any event or entry and refuse any nomination.
9. In the event of a tie for first place, competitors concerned will compete in a further round to decide the winner.
10. A 100% refund of the deposit shall be given if the competitor withdraws more than 4 days prior to 8am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws within 48 hours prior to 8am on the first morning of the program, committees are entitled to keep the entire amount of the nomination fee, unless when extenuating circumstances apply.
11. Refunds are applicable to late scratching and will be at the discretion of the Committee with each case to be treated on its merits.
12. All conditions to apply at the time of draft and nominations on any event will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.
13. Only Committee and Stewards are allowed to work in the ring.
14. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint against a judge's decision must lodge the complaint in writing, plus a fee of \$50, with the secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$50 fee is forfeited. Judges may only be approached/questioned by a single team member.
15. Competitors are allowed to ride in saddle of their choice and horses can be worked in any bits, bosals or hackamores. However the horse must have free use of its head and any type of tie-down, running reins, head checks etc. must not be used. The judge has the right to call any competitor to inspect his gear and if their gear is illegal, the competitor will be compelled to remove the offending article before competing.
16. Suitable spurs are allowed but no whip of any kind may be carried or used by a competitor.
17. Competitors under the age of 18 years must wear skullcaps in all events and in the main arena. The chinstrap must be securely fastened under the chin.
18. No alcohol to be brought into Showgrounds or consumed outside the Bar fenced area.
